



# Constitution

The group shall be known as Loud & Proud Cheerleading

## PURPOSE

Bringing together young people and promoting the value of friendship through team work and entertaining activity

## ELIGIBILITY

A candidate must be medically fit, and if under the age of 18 years old provide parental permission.

A candidate may be male or female.

Acceptance of a candidate shall be on the basis of ability, the coach's agreement, acceptance of the rules, and without prejudice of race creed or colour.

## MEMBERSHIP

Membership fees will be set annually

Fees will be paid monthly for a 12 month period Sept-Aug

## FINANCES

The club will have a bank account in the name Loud & Proud Cheerleading

The Treasurer will be responsible for the club accounts.

The accounts will be presented by the treasurer at the AGM

The accounts will follow the pattern of the season Sept-Aug

## DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MANAGER/COACH

The coach/managers is responsible for

Ensuring all squad members are insured, that safety is the top priority at all times, that first aid is available and emergency contact list is kept up to date and present at all times.

The safety and conduct guidelines of the Sport Cheer UK are upheld

Organising and arranging training schedule, equipment, training facilities, travel and events.

## FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES

The money raised from fund raising events will be to fund addition agreed expenses, such as extra items of kit or equipment or to purchase new/ replacement uniforms.

All fund raising activities will be approved by the majority of the squad and with the approval of coach/manager.

## COMMITTEE

The committee will meet quarterly or as needed

The club will hold an AGM every calendar year

The committee is responsible for the management of the club and all its properties, funds and affairs

The committee will have a minimum of 4 members and a maximum of 20

The club can provide costs to cover coach education courses and other running costs for coaches and members if deemed as beneficial to the club by the committee

Members of the committee can be re-elected an unlimited amount of times

The committee can delegate roles to sub committees who will report back to the club committee and reserve the right to dissolve any such subcommittee at any point if agreed by the committee
